THE HOME

St Augustine's House supports 16 Service Users aged 18+ years, who are in need of a period of continued rehabilitation, following discharge from hospital or other institutional settings.

The House is located in a residential area within walking distance from South Croydon's Brighton Road local amenities and about 5 minutes walk from Saderstead Train Station and 10 minutes walk from South Croydon Train Station. The house is a large double fronted detached building with a large back garden with space allocated for Service User garden allotments.

Christ the King Residential Care Homes is registered and in compliance with the Care Quality Commission since 2004.

INSIDE THE HOUSE

St Augustine's House is a spacious and attractive Care Home. All the facilities meet the current regulatory Standards. The home is designed to give each service user their own privacy and space with great focus on developing people's Activities of Daily Livings skills. The home has a large kitchen and a large open dining area. A 10 station computer room for up to 10 Service Users at one given time. A Sensory/ Quite time room with library facilities. Allocated kitchen space for Service User led cooking classes to improve our service user's cooking skills aiming at promoting people's independence as part of their recovery journey with us.

BEDROOMS

There are 16 bedrooms St Augustine's House, which are all fully furnished to a high standard. The service user will be the only person to have access to his/her bedroom, however staff may need to enter on the following grounds:

- In the event of an emergency
- For health and safety reasons
- If they have the occupant's permission

Individual service users will be able to meet other service users and integrate into the community by getting involved in different activities in the local community, either by going to a day centre, college, gym or by being assisted to find work or work experience.

Staff will be able to help service users to organise this. The staff will also help with other issues such as:-

- **Medication management and compliance to treatment**
- **Physical health needs**
- **Monitoring and managing substance misuse problems**
- **Activities to help manage Health issues/ anxieties**
- **Daily living skills, such as attending to personal hygiene, shopping, cooking, budgeting etc**
- **Career development/ CV writing**
- **Laundry Services**
- **Leading and Teaching Classes to other service users such as Art.**
- **Indoor activities such as weekly exercise classes**
- **Fictional story writing classes**

SUMMARY OF RESOURCES

- Christ the King Residential Care Homes will offer the following to all service users:
- An individual Care Co-ordinator/ key worker assigned to each Service User.
- A Care Manager to ensure the smooth operation and running of the Home.
- Accurate record keeping on all service users.
- Continuous partnership between service users and his/her Care Co-ordinator.
- Holistic Care Planning targeting at the service user's re-introduction to his/her community.
- Three monthly review meetings involving members(s) from the service user's funding authority.
- Weekly house meetings for Service Users.
- Support to service users to learn new skills or acquire qualifications through outside agencies, colleges and appropriate workplaces.
- Working in partnership with the service user, the Multi- disciplinary team (i.e. CPN, Social Workers, psychiatrist, support staff etc), families and relevant outside agencies.
- Preparation of meals by staff with assistance from Service User

ACHIEVING POSITIVE OUTCOMES

At Christ the King we focus on encouraging people to take control and have belief in their potential, we can make positive outcomes a reality for all our service users, regardless of their age or presumed ability. Promoting our service user's ability is key to our Recovery Model.

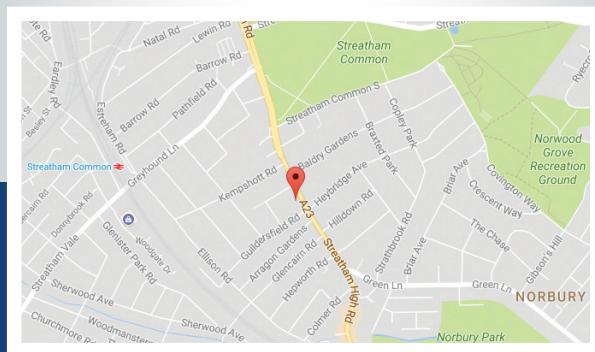
